horizons - the range of limit of experience or knowledge

incentive - something that motivates or induces

<u>recreation</u>- something done for relaxation or amusement, or enjoyment

unfettered - released from physical or mental bonds; free and unrestrained

<u>hyperbole</u>- an extreme exaggeration

imagery- use of words and phrases that require the readers to use their senses

ode- a long poem that expresses a feeling, such as praise repetition- when the same word, phrase, or pattern occurs more than once
